## LITERACY LABORATORY WRITING ACTIVITY

### FOCUS:

### OPINION WRITING & CULTURAL ANALYSIS

### TEXT/MEDIA ANCHOR: BAD BUNNY'S SUPER BOWL HALFTIME PERFORMANCE

#### Learning Targets

- I can plan an opinion essay that clearly states my opinion and supports it with reasons, facts, and details.
- I can give kind, helpful, and specific feedback to a partner to help them strengthen their writing.

## PHASE 1: VIEWING AND CLOSE OBSERVATION

#### Purpose: Build shared background knowledge and attend closely to cultural symbols.

- First Viewing (No Writing):
- Students watch the halftime performance straight through to experience it as an audience.
- Second Viewing (Guided Focus):
- Students rewatch with a specific lens, noting:
  - Clothing and symbols
  - Music and dance styles
  - Stage design and imagery
  - Language and cultural references
- Teacher Prompt During Viewing:
  - What do you notice?
  - What stands out as intentional or symbolic?
  - What feels connected to culture or identity?

Students jot quick notes or sketches in their notebooks.

## PHASE 2: DISCUSSION & MEANING-MAKING

#### Purpose: Rehearse ideas orally before writing.

Facilitate a whole-group or small-group discussion using prompts such as:

- What messages might Bad Bunny be communicating through this performance?
- Which details feel specifically connected to Puerto Rico or Latino culture?
- Why might this message matter on a stage as large as the Super Bowl?

Encourage students to reference specific evidence from what they saw.

## PHASE 3: WRITING TASK – OPINION ESSAY

#### Writing Prompt:

What are your thoughts about this performance and its significance? Do you think Bad Bunny made a statement about his culture? If so, what was the statement, and how did he communicate it?

#### Writing Expectations:

- Clearly state an opinion about the performance
- Provide at least two reasons supporting that opinion
- Use specific details from the performance as evidence
- Explain why the performance matters culturally or socially
